

ADVISER OF THE YEAR AWARD

Nomination Procedure:

1. Nominations for high school and middle level may be made by an adviser on his/her own behalf or by others on behalf of an adviser. If made by others, the adviser must fill out the nomination form and a letter on behalf of the adviser may be submitted by someone else. The letter must accompany the nomination form.
2. Nominations must be received by April 1 by Mary Hahn, 7535 La Madera NE, Albuquerque NM 87109.
3. The nominee must currently be a student council adviser, or have been a student council adviser in the immediate past school year.
4. The adviser who is nominated must attend the annual National Association of Student Councils Conference held near the end of June or early July following the upcoming annual NMASC Conference.

Selection Procedure:

1. A committee composed of three previous NMASC Advisers of the Year will select the NMASC High School Adviser of the Year and the NMASC Middle Level Adviser of the Year from the nominations presented. This shall be done prior to the annual NMASC Conference.
2. Introduction of the NMASC High School Adviser of the Year and the NMASC Middle Level Adviser of the Year will be made at a general session of the upcoming annual NMASC Conference.

Award:

1. A plaque will be presented to the NMASC High School Adviser of the Year and the NMASC Middle Level Adviser of the Year during the annual conference.
2. An "Adviser of the Year" ring will be presented to the NMASC High School Adviser of the Year and the NMASC Middle Level Adviser of the Year during the annual conference by Campus Specialties, Herff Jones.
3. One of the two advisers will be selected as New Mexico's Adviser of the Year nominee for the National Association of Student Council's Adviser of the Year (Warren E. Shull award).
